## **Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions**

### **Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol**

- (1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-
  - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- (2) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

### **Mandatory condition where the premises licence includes a Condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity:**

- (1) Each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- (2) But nothing in (1) above requires such a condition to be imposed—
  - (a) in respect of premises within paragraph 8(3)(a) of Schedule 2 to the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (c. 12) (premises with premises licences authorising plays or films), or
  - (b) in respect of premises in relation to—
    - (i) any occasion mentioned in paragraph 8(3)(b) or (c) of that Schedule (premises being used exclusively by club with club premises certificate, under a temporary event notice authorising plays or films or under a gaming licence), or
    - (ii) any occasion within paragraph 8(3)(d) of that Schedule (occasions prescribed by regulations under that Act).
- (3) For the purposes of this section—
  - (a) “security activity” means an activity to which paragraph 2(1)(a) of that Schedule applies, and
  - (b) paragraph 8(5) of that Schedule (interpretation of references to an occasion) applies as it applies in relation to paragraph 8 of that Schedule.

## **Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule**

### **Promotion of licensing objectives**

#### **a) General – all four licensing objectives**

- Staff will be instructed on the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003 and in particular our operating schedule.

#### **b) The prevention of crime and disorder**

- We will not allow drunken, violent or quarrelsome behaviour on the premises.
- Anyone behaving as such will be removed and if necessary the police will be informed.
- We will not serve persons who appear to be drunk or who we suspect may be underage.

#### **c) Public safety**

- The building has been totally refurbished and all building and fire regulations have been complied with.
- Mr Mark Jones, fire officer, visited the premises on 1<sup>st</sup> October 2007 and can confirm this.
- The premises also has facilities and good access for disabled people.
- We have an emergency first aid kit and all staff members know where it is located.
- Public liability insurance is in force and we will advise our insurers of the change of hours if this application is successful

#### **d) The prevention of public nuisance**

- Live and recorded music will be an occasional feature and will be ancillary to dining.
- Doors and windows will be kept closed on New Years Eve.
- We will encourage our customers to be respectful of the neighbours and to leave quietly

#### **e) The protection of children from harm**

- Children under the age of eighteen will not be sold alcohol.
- Staff are instructed to be vigilant and to ask for identification if they are uncertain as to age.
- We will only accept photographic identification.
- If they are unsure, staff are instructed not to serve the customer.
