#### Coedwig Gymunedol Long Wood Community Woodland

Allt Cefn Foel Llanfair Clydogau Lampeter Ceredigion SA48 8NF

Longwood community woodland is the largest community owned woodland in Wales and has been since its inception in 2003. In that time there has always been public access to all parts of the woodland including the use of the track from Longwood to Olwen wood.

Historically this route has been used by local people for more years than can be remembered to walk the woods and travel the 4 miles to Llangybi from Lampeter. Itinerant farm workers also used the track to the woodlands, often traveling from many miles away for seasonal work.

For many years horse riders have frequented the track parking down by the main visitor centre and riding through the woods to Lampeter and back. This was the only accessible and safe route that they could take that did not put them at risk from cattle and stallions that would be kept in the adjacent fields. It was also a regular route used by students attending the university to access the Woodlands from the back of the Campus.

Longwood has permissive access for the use of the track currently to extract timber and maintain Olwen wood with our team of volunteers and staff members. We fully support the application for full rights of way through the woods.

This track is an important public access route that connects many communities along the valley from Lampeter to Llangybi. A diverse mix of people use this route to walk, ride, cycle, exercise and explore parts of the natural world. It is a vital resource that needs to be maintained and kept open to the public for many future generations to enjoy. Access to nature is vital to maintain mental health as well as physical and this track plays a critical part in giving people just that.

Rights of way through the countryside need to be maintained so that people have access to the wonderful natural resources that we have on our doorstep and the community at Longwood will do everything in its power to keep these roots open.



Hello,

I want to send you this witness statement, to help the Ramblers claim to rights of way through Longwood:

My name is Joanne Camlin, I have lived in the Lampeter area since 2003. In 2010, my family and I moved into rented accommodation 'Allt Goch' which is a house just on the very edge of Longwood, about 100 yards as the crow flies, down from the path that goes through into Longwood itself, and a couple of hundred yards up to the currently disputed access from Olwen wood into Longwood.

Personally, my husband and I and our two children used to go through the gates either to Longwood or through the other gates to Olwen wood at least once a week in the summer months, and at least once a fortnight the rest of the year, even in big snow drifts! We would often walk or cycle all the way from Longwood through Olwen wood into Lampeter -it provides a safe cycle route, that's not on a main road. My children's friends would sometimes walk from Lampeter, through Olwen wood and the two gates between the woods, to get to Hobbs Garden and the stage area. I know that students used to also do this, because sometimes when we got to Hobbs garden, there would be students already there, who told us that they had walked from Lampeter.

My children's primary school, Ysgol y Dderi, used to have an annual cycle trip with the schoolchildren, and in 2013 and 14, I think, they did this through Longwood, all the way through Olwen wood, through the 2 gates between the woods, and down into Lampeter to refresh at the Rugby Club.

Whilst living at this place, if we were outside we could also hear people in the distance, using the path, especially the sound of the 2 gates opening and closing. If one gate clink clunked, then we knew that in a minute or two the other one would also do the same, as people passed along the area between the woods. On a summers day, this was an hourly occurrence. We also often heard the sounds of horses, 2 or 3 times a week in the spring and summer months, and the horses left their own evidence of course, we often saw the prints of horse hooves, and plenty of horse manure! We heard the shouts of children as they walked or cycled past.

When we ourselves went up to the woods, we would see many people, most of whom had come from Lampeter; solo walkers, dog walkers, groups of walkers, the Sarn Helen running group, horse riders, parents with children of all ages, in pushchairs, or on bikes, there have been organized mushroom identification walks which started in Lampeter and walked the full length of the woods, there have been organized well being walks for people with mental health issues, again, starting at Lampeter and walking the full length of the woods. There have been 2 large theatrical productions in Longwood - A Midsummer Nights Dream in around 2012, and The Tempest, in around 2013. In order to get to the stage area, many people walked there through Olwen woods, through the 2 gates between the woods, to get there.

We no longer live directly next to the woods, since 2017, but we were there for 7 years. We heard and saw a lot of people going between the 2 woods, using these gates. In all this time, to my knowledge, there was never any problem with the gates. We still live in the Lampeter area, and for the past 5 years, my teenager and her friends have met up in Lampeter and walked or cycled through the woods during the holidays, to have a picnic up at the stage, or to enjoy the space at Hobbs garden. Occasionally, as they got older, they would go from Lampeter all the way through the woods to Llanfair Clydogau and back to Lampeter along the road.

This path, between the two woods, is a well used path, perfect for pushchairs, bikes, and horses; personally I used this path a lot from 2010 until very recently, when the gates were covered by the landowner in barbed wire, and I have witnessed a lot of others using the path too, from 2010 until the present day. Just last weekend, on a hot late summers day, I cycled from the Llanfair end of Longwood all the way to the blocked gate, and only met one single person in 2 hours walking the woods. Sadly, this is very unusual, local people are now being put off using Longwood, due to the blocked access. This person had climbed over the gates, risking the barbed wire. I, on a bike, when I reached the gates, turned around and rode back the way I had come.
