

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## CEREDIGION COUNTY COUNCIL TOWN & POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847 (SECTION 21)

### RAS BRYNDIODDEF 2024

NOTICE is hereby given that the Ceredigion County Council with the consent of Carmarthenshire County Council has made the following Order under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 for the Prevention of Obstruction etc.

WHEREAS during certain hours on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> June 2024, between the hours of 17:00 – 21:00 hours due to the Ras Bryndioddef taking place, that sections of the roads known as the A475 from Adpar Roundabout to the entrance of Cilgwyn Hotel and the B4571 from Adpar Roundabout to the entrance of Bryndioddef Isaf in the county of Ceredigion, will be thronged and liable to be obstructed. Ceredigion County Council with the consent of Carmarthenshire County Council pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 DO HEREBY ORDER AND DIRECT that for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the said roads on the said day the following regulations shall be observed:-

1. Subject to those provisions contained in articles 3 and 4, those sections of road known as the A475 from Adpar Roundabout to the entrance of Cilgwyn Hotel and the B4571 from Adpar Roundabout to the entrance of Bryndioddef Isaf in the county of Ceredigion shall be closed to all vehicular traffic including pedal cycles between the hours of 17:00 – 21:00 on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> June 2024.
2. Subject to those provisions contained in articles 3 and 4, those sections of road known as the A475 from Adpar to the entrance of Cilgwyn Hotel to its junction with the A486, the B4571 from the entrance of Bryndioddef Isaf to its junction with the A486, the A475 Bridge Street from Adpar roundabout to its junction with the A484, Newcastle Emlyn, the B4333 from Adpar roundabout to its junction with the B4570, the B4570 from its junction with the B4333 to its junction with the A484, the U5218 from its junction with the B4571 to its junction with the U5222 and the U5222 from its junction with the U5218 to its junction with the B4333 shall be incidentally closed to all vehicular traffic including pedal cycles at their junctions with sections of road mentioned in article 1. between the hours of 17:00 – 21:00 on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> June 2024.
3. The provisions of article 1 and 2 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions referred to therein are indicated by traffic signs or designated stewards.
4. Nothing in article 1 and 2 of this order shall apply to any vehicle being used by the emergency services, vehicles being used in connection with the events giving rise to this order, or anything done with the permission or under the direction of a police officer.

The alternative route is as follows: from a point north-east of the closures, travel south on the A486 and continue to the roundabout, Llandysul bypass. Take the second exit at the roundabout continuing on the A486. Travel to the roundabout and take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit at the roundabout continuing on the A486. Continue on the A486 to its junction with the A484. Turn right onto the A484 and continue on the A484 for approximately 16 miles to its junction with the B4570 and a point west of the closures. A total distance of approximately 24 miles.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The penalty for infringement of the said Regulations is a fine not exceeding one thousand pounds.
