NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **LLANARTH** Community Council intends to Co-opt **1** member to fill the vacancy that exists in the office of Councillor for the **LLANARTH** Community Council.

Expressions of interest are being sought from members of the public who meet the following qualifications and are interested in representing their town/community on the aforementioned Town/Community Council. You must be a British citizen, an eligible Commonwealth citizen, a citizen of any member state of the European Union or a qualifying foreign citizen; be 18 years of age or over; and meet at least one of the following criteria:

- registered as a local government elector for the area named above; or
- during the whole of the last 12 months occupied as owner or tenant of land or other premises in the town/community named above; or
- your principal or only place of work during the last 12 months has been in the town/community named above; or
- you have during the whole of the last 12 months resided in the town/community or within 4.8 kilometres of it.¹
