

Safe Routes to School new path at Talgarreg Primary School

Dear pupils, parents and staff,

September 2016

We are pleased to announce that a new path has been installed providing a safer pedestrian link between the school and the Village Hall which is used daily for school activities and the after school club. This is a welcome improvement as previously the children were walked by staff along the road which doesn't have any footway provision.

The new path has an artificial surface which is suited for use all year round and has a lovely bright red surface which was the preferred colour of choice made by the pupils themselves.

The path has been implemented by Highways Services at Ceredigion County Council after successfully bidding for a 'Safe Routes in Communities' grant from the Welsh Government.

Ceredigion County Council has also gratefully obtained kind permission from the Talgarreg Village Hall committee to allow school staff to park their vehicles in the car park. This will help reduce the number of vehicles parking on the highway in front of the school and improve road safety in this area.



Parents and guardians are also permitted to use this car park at school opening and closing times and we strongly encourage this to avoid the congestion outside the school front gate.

Please do not drive your vehicles down the narrow lane behind Bro Emrys as this will endanger the children using this path.

Dogs are not permitted access into the school field.

We hope that with everyone's continued community cooperation this path will become a popular Safe Route to our school.
